



# ENTERING OBJECTS

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This document explains how to capture objects using Tedi's object editor. We will take the example of the Beazley Archive Pottery Database (BAPD): <http://www.beazley.ox.ac.uk/index.htm>

## 2. PRINCIPLE

Each crater in the Beazley collection will be represented by a Tedi object as follows:


- Create an instance of the concept corresponding to the type of crater;
- Identify each object with its number in the Beazley collection prefixed by 'Beazley-'
- Link it to the web address of the object in the Beazley database using the tag 'skos:exactMatch'
- You can also use a 'foaf:depiction' tag to link the object instance you have created to the web address of the associated image, if there is one. Note that not all images of objects in the Beazley collections have web addresses linked to them.

#### 4: Create the corresponding object

- 1: **New** creates the object with its Beazley-205795 identifier (the prefix 'Beazley-' will be used each time a new identifier is defined)
- 2: **Double click** on object ID opens the link editing window
- 3: **Add external link** to view possible links. Choose skos:exactMatch
